Herb & Fiber Festival: June 1 – 2 10am – 5pm This marks the 35th year for this signature festival that draws hundreds of people looking to start their gardens and get closer to nature. There will be hanging baskets, bedding flats, perennials, annuals, garden artists and herbs. Join us Saturday for our annual “Soup at the Sawmill” luncheon. Starting at 11:30, you receive a handmade pottery soup bowl (which is yours to keep), homemade soup, bread, dessert and a drink for \$12.

Wood Carvers Festival: July 13 – 14 10am – 5pm For 35 years, this festival has featured carefully hand-carved creations. These impressive works of art are displayed throughout the weekend and many are available for purchase. Carving competitions, exhibitions, demonstration, classes, and vendors round out the event.

Ladies Tea & Vintage Fashion Show: July 27 2pm – 4pm Join us for afternoon tea and delicious pastries as we learn about styles of fashion over the decades through displays of traditional clothing, wedding gowns and accessories.

Chainsaw Carvers Festival: September 13 – 15 10am – 5pm Auctions on Saturday at 4 pm and Sunday at 3:30 pm. Come see carvers in action as they create beautiful works of art from a simple log. Stay for the auctions to bid on and purchase some of these beautiful pieces!

Vintage & Antique Market: October 12 10am – 5pm A new indoor/outdoor flea market showcasing antique and repurposed goods including jewelry, home décor, furnishings, tools, paints, parts and pieces. Our Creative Classrooms will host experts sharing their know-how, tips and tricks to tackle your own.

Gingerbread Tour: November 1 – 3 Part of the annual Gingerbread Tour from Cook Forest to Historic Brookville, shop our bountiful craft market where more than 50 local artisans display their hand-crafted items. All work is juried to ensure the highest quality and craftsmanship. Indoor event with tables provided.

Festival of Trees: December 6 -7 10 am – 5 pm Now in its 3rd year at the Sawmill Center, enjoy live entertainment, Christmas music and delicious foods while shopping for unique art and craft gifts.
