The Sawmill Art Center in Cook Forest State Park is excited to announce we will be having our annual Woodcarvers Show and Competition on Saturday, July 9th and Sunday, July 10th. This year's theme is "Nature in Our Forest." The original theme "Disney" was changed due to copyright issues. I apologize for any inconvenience or confusion.

After some discussion with our judges, the decision was made to simplify our entry form and eliminate some divisions and categories. We hope this makes entering carvings easier with less confusion. If you have any questions about the division or category, please talk to the staff who will be checking in your carvings for the event. As our show grows, we will once again start to add more to the entry form.

Carvings will be judged with ribbons and prize money awarded. Judging is scheduled for 1:00 p.m. on Friday, July 8th. All entries must be entered into competition by 12:00 p.m., Friday, July 8th to be part of judging and be eligible for ribbons and prizes. The drop off days and times are on the entry form included with this information.

We are also accepting registration forms from vendors who would like to set up for the weekend. The cost is \$50.00 and any vendor that participates, can submit 5 entries for free into the show. We also welcome any carver who would like to demonstrate throughout the weekend. Set up is free for demonstrating. We are limited on inside spots, so they are first come, first serve. Outside spaces are available.

There is a carving class scheduled with Bob Stadtlander for July 11th-15th. More information will be available for the class closer to the event. The information will also be available on our website.
