Fees for the event will be \$75 for 2024 vendors and \$100 for new applicants. The fee will increase to \$100 for all participants for 2026.

Money for all other festivals will be due 6 weeks prior to the event. We will try to honor all special requests but must do what is best for the Sawmill Center and the festivals.
