As one of the premier destinations in Cook Forest State Park, thousands visit us each year for our live theater performances, unique festivals, and a bountiful craft market full of one-of-a-kind handcrafted items.

All items placed for sale are handmade, handcrafted or created in a way that upholds the unique artistic value within the Sawmill Centers' mission. Vendors with items that promote the rich history and natural beauty of the local area will also be considered. Food vendors are welcome to apply. Each application will be evaluated for appropriateness by the Sawmill Center for the Arts.

Here is a brief description of each festival we will host in 2025. Please visit our website sawmill.org for more information or email info@sawmill.org.

Herb & Fiber Festival: May 31-June 1, Saturday from 9 am – 4 pm & Sunday from 10 am – 3 pm. This marks the 40th year for this signature festival that draws hundreds of people looking to start their gardens and get closer to nature. There will be baskets, bedding flats, perennials, annuals, herbs, garden artists, and more. Annual soup luncheon fundraiser will be on Sat, May 31st from 11:30-2.

Woodcarvers and Woodworking Festival: July 12-13, Saturday 10 am – 5 pm & Sunday 10 am -3 pm. This festival features carefully hand-carved creations which are judged by professional carvers. These impressive works of art are displayed throughout the weekend, and many are available for purchase. Demonstrations and a woodcarving class will round out the event.

Chainsaw Carvers Festival: September 12-14, 10 am – 5 pm. Auctions on Saturday at 4 pm and Sunday at 3:30 pm. Come see carvers in action as they create beautiful works of art from a simple log. Stay for the auctions to bid on and purchase some of these beautiful pieces!

Gingerbread Tour: November 7-9, Friday & Saturday 9 am – 5 pm & Sunday 9 am - 3 pm. Part of the annual Gingerbread Tour from Cook Forest to Historic Brookville. Our bountiful craft market boasts more than 85 local artisans displaying their hand-crafted items in addition to the vendors setting up for the weekend. All work is juried to ensure the highest quality and craftsmanship. Indoor event with tables and chairs provided. We will represent over 100+ artists for the event.
